Licensure of Structural Engineers is a provision in a jurisdiction's statutes (enacted by the legislature) or rules (established by the licensing board) and generally varies state-by-state. Arizona currently requires Structural Engineering applicants to complete the 16-hour NCEES SE Exam and have 3 or 4 years of qualified experience after completing an approved Master's or Bachelor's degree program, respectively, in order to receive professional registration.

SEAOA - Structural Licensure

Interested engineers (other than structural) registered in Arizona for at least three years who demonstrate they have operated as a "project prime professional," as defined by the Arizona Board of Technical Registration ; To be considered, non-structural engineers must complete the Application for Enrollment into Training Class Form (PDF). This application is not required for professionals who meet the qualifications listed in the "Professional Qualifications" section above.

For applicants for professional engineer licensure under §903.A.1 of these rules, the "verifiable record of four years or more of pro- gressive experience obtained subsequent to meeting the educational and applicable experience qualifications to be an engineer intern" must be gained by the time of application for licensure.

When Can I Take the PE Exam? States Allowing Examination ...

Generally, a candidate for engineering licensure will graduate from a four-year ABET accredited engineering program, take the Fundamentals of Engineering (FE) Examination during his or her senior year, start work in an engineering position immediately after graduation, and begin to accumulate qualifying engineering experience in order to take the Principles and Practice of Engineering (PE) Examination at the earliest opportunity.
