It includes all 7 mandolin keys A, B, C, D, E, F, G with their 1, 4, 5 and V7 fingerings in first position. This chart make a great reference to add to your jam notebook. The 1, 4, 5 chord relationship is standard in western music for rock, folk, country, and blues. The 1, 4, 5 refers to the chords that are played in a song and their relationship to each other.

### Fingerings for the Seven Mandolin Keys with 1, 4,5 Chords

Open mandolin chords are chords formed on the neck of the mandolin utilizing open strings. The following is by no means a comprehensive charting of the open chords available on the mandolin. However, there are enough major chords here, as well as minors and sevenths, to play a lot of tunes. Especially in the common keys of C, G, D and A.

The great thing about the mandolin is that it's tuned symmetrically (open 5ths), meaning that you can use the same chord shapes across all the strings. For example, play the 2nd string, 2nd fret and the 1st string, 3rd fret.

Think of a key as a little family of chords. Like a regular family, the chords in a key have a relationship to each other, and each is given a number. In bluegrass type music, the most common family of chords or key are 1, 4 and 5. Remember those numbers. So in the key of A, for example, A=1, B=2, C=3, D=4, E=5, F=6, G=7 and A is also 8.

### How to Jam on the Mandolin | Native Ground

Most songs use about three chords in a key, sometimes two, sometimes four (or five or more), but you'll have 90% of material covered if you can play the common three chords in a few keys. Learn just the chords G, C, and D. Find a bluegrass song that uses those chords and play it. This is the key of G. Learn some more songs with those chords.

### Some C Major Chord Progressions for Mandolin

Especially for four-note chords (e.g., a G7 chord is made up of the notes GBDF), on a four-string instrument like the mandolin you may end up duplicating some notes while leaving others out (e.g., 0323 is a commonly-used G7 with notes GFBG, which has two Gs but leaves out the D entirely).

In the mandolin chord charts below, each horizontal line represents a pair of mandolin strings. The E string is the one closest to the floor, as you hold your mandolin in playing position, and the G string is closest to the ceiling. The numbers represent the fret. Be sure to place your fingers between,

not on, the fret.

#### **Easy Two-Finger Mandolin Chords | Native Ground**

The common basic chords of E, G, A, C, and D can be bumped up a step or two, or even more on a guitar. The same method works to some extent on a mandolin. One of the easiest chords on a mandolin is G major. If you need to play a song in the key of A, putting a capo on the second fret converts the tuning from G-D-A-E to A-E-B-F#.

#### **Get Choppin' With These Essential, And Simple, Folk ...**

In this case, you need to understand what other chords can be used. Remember that the G major key has one sharp, a F sharp, meaning that the notes (and respective chords) in G major key are: G, A, B, C, D, E, F#. As this is a major key, the chord type for each position (from first to seventh) is
